MESSAGE FROM FR MICHAEL Today is a Day of Special Prayer for Education. Education Sunday is one of the oldest Days of Special Prayer in the liturgical calendar of England and Wales. Education remains the largest charitable activity of the Church in this country, with many of our schools established for poor immigrant children in the 19th century. At the time, education was seen as the principal means of handing on the faith and improving the spiritual, moral, social and cultural lives of children and young people. We pray for all involved in Catholic education today. Last Tuesday I celebrated Mass for the staff at Harrytown Catholic High School to mark the start of the new school year. Parishioners are welcome to attend the voluntary Mass in the school on Fridays at 8.15am.
