MESSAGE FROM FR MICHAEL At the Masses this weekend we have a Pastoral Letter from the Bishop on the Assisted Dying/Suicide Bill coming before parliament. This worrying development is something that should concern us all and I urge parishioners to contact their local MP about this matter. There are further details on how to do this below.

This Sunday is Prisoners' Sunday when the Church encourages everyone to reflect on and pray for prisoners and their families and marks the start of the annual week of prayer to raise awareness of issues faced by those affected by the criminal justice system across the Christian denominations.
