MESSAGE FROM FR MICHAEL On Tuesday we celebrate the feast of Our Lady of Lourdes, and it is also World Day of Prayer for the Sick. Lourdes, as a centre of Marian pilgrimage welcomes many sick pilgrims every year and indeed the sick have a privileged place there. This is the result of a long tradition of welcoming the sick to the sanctuary. In fact, as early as 1858, the year of the first apparitions, the sick or the parents of sick children flocked to Lourdes. I hope to travel to Lourdes on the annual Diocesan Pilgrimage at the end of July. Let us remember the sick in our prayers and especially the sick and housebound of our own parish that they may be helped by the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary – Our Lady of Lourdes.
