<u>The transport</u> will be of two kinds: by train or by your own car. For those coming <u>by train</u> from Stockport. Parking can be found at the NCP next to the station (Exchange Station, 11 Railway Road, **SK1 3SW)** We will convene at platform one at 9:30am and leave Stockport at 9:40am, arriving in Shrewsbury for 10:46am followed by a short 15 min walk to the Orchard Café for a pit stop before Mass. For those coming <u>by car</u>, the journey from the church is one hour and fifty minutes. Parking can be found at St Julian Friars (SY1 1XL) the ticket machine takes card payments. From the car park there is a short 5 min walk up Town Walls to the Cathedral Café to meet the group. **Think about car sharing too.** <u>Cost</u> - The price of a train ticket is around £31.30 [without a railcard].
