## SUNDAY 6<sup>th</sup> APRIL 2025 FIFTH SUNDAY OF LENT

MESSAGE FROM FR MICHAEL There is a Joint Pastoral Letter from Cardinal Vincent Nichols, along with all the Bishops of England and Wales, regarding The Terminally III Adults (End of Life) Bill which will be read at all Masses this weekend. The urgency of this matter cannot be overstated, as we now have less than four weeks to oppose medically assisted suicide. I will be writing to the local MP once again about this crucial issue, and I strongly encourage parishioners to do the same.

Cards are available at the back of church for this purpose. Previously, there was a good response from parishioners before the Bill's second reading in Parliament, and I hope there will be a similar response this time around. Let us also keep this matter at the forefront of our prayers.
